When you head out to the UTPB Permian Basin Softball Fields to catch a game, expect to see a lot of changes.

Not to the field or to the facilities but to the team.

Nine of the 16 players on the 2008 roster are playing softball for the first time at UTPB.

However, this is not a team of first-time college ball players. In fact, only three players are freshmen.

The rest of the team has veteran experience that head coach Danny Dunaway hopes will make an impact in the Heartland Conference.

"An experienced player can bring a lot to a team," Dunaway

explained. "They are used to the speed of the game and have had the opportunity to see pitchers at this level."

In addition to the new faces there is a new attitude for the team.

Dunaway said this group has done more to get ready for the season than any other team.

The ladies have endured a grueling off-season program as well as have had many team-building events.

"We had them do a pretty intense weight training program in the fall and the early part of this spring mixed in with a lot of conditioning," said Dunaway.

"We've also had a few retreats

and the girls had a sleepover. We wanted to do what we could to bring them together before the season started."

Last season the Falcons posted a 12-29 record. However, the 2008 team has more pitching experience and more depth in the other positions.

Dunaway hopes the additions to the team along with a solid core of returns will help his team to be more competitive in the conference play.

"Last season we got a good idea of what it was like to play at the NCAA D-II level," Dunaway said. "I think this year's team is more focused and ready to face the challenges that lie ahead."
